ID-AYU0044) with 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa - 05 seats (ii) Kriya Sharir - 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra - 05 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Jammu Institute of Ayurved & Research, Nardani Raipur, Ban Talab Road, Jammu Tawi-181123 (Inst. ID-AYU0044) inspection of your College was conducted on 18.05.2023 & 19.05.2023 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa 05 seats and (ii) Kriya Sharir 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra 05 seats for the academic session 2023-24 under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

1) Availability of total teaching staff is $\frac{Available}{Required} \times 100\% = \frac{26}{30} \times 100\% = 86.66\%$ (excluding Excess)

- 3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the 47th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 13.07.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice)of even no. dated 15.07.2023 to appear on 19.07.2023 before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the conditional permission to your college with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa 05 seats and (ii) Kriya Sharir 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra 05 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied for the Academic Year 2023-24.
- 4. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions vide JIAR/2023/720 dated 17.07.2023 against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, Dr. Sharda Principal appeared before the Hearing Committee on 19.07.2023 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

We received mail 17th March 2023 (screenshot enclosed)by your kind self stating withdrawal of this relaxation policy for the Session 2023-24 vide Ref. No. 26-75/2023-Ay (Visitation) Dated 13th March 2023. By that time the Part-I was already initiated by NCISM on 15th March 2023 (screenshot enclosed). During this period, we tried getting Higher Faculties in the concerned Departments by putting Advertisement in News Paper/Social Media but we didn't receive a single application because no College/Institute would relieve any Faculty from their Institute during this period of submission of Part-I. (Annexure-I)

Moreover Dr. Parul Anand who was appointed on Ist March 2023 (copy enclosed) as Assistant Professor in the Department of Dravyaguna under the relaxation support is having experience of 4 year 7 months (copies certificate experience enclosed) till date and she will be promoted Associate Professor on 10th of December 2023 before commencement of New Session 2023-24. So we request your good self to kindly consider her as she holds Ph.D from I.T.R.A Jamnagar and also she has done her UG from Rajiv Gandhi Govt. Post Graduate Ayurvedic College, Paprola, PG from National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur. (Annexue-II)

Τf she considered, then it will compensate the deficit of 01 Higher Faculty in the Department of Dravyaguna. Regarding shortage of Higher Faculties in the remaining 3 Departments i.e. Rog Nidana, Shalakya Tantra and Samhita Siddhanta will get covered under 10% relaxation for Higher Faculty as per MSR 2016.

Shortcoming of Teaching Staffs for PG Existing- There is no deficiency of Associate Professor for PG in Shalya Tantra as Dr. Sarika Jamwal has been appointed as Associate Professor in the Department Shalya of Tantra on 19th April 2023 and she joined on 17th May 2023 and the same was informed to NCISM through email (copies enclosed). But she was not linked with our College before the submission of Part-I and also till date because her resignation acceptance, Relieving and Experience was pending from the previous Institute. After her complaint to NCISM regarding her issue, she got a mail from NCISM on 24th 2023 regarding approval of Relieving (screen shot enclosed). Till date also, her Experience and Relieving is pending from her previous Institute so we are not able to link her in our portal. Also we have submitted her Teacher Affidavit (copies enclosed) (Annexure-III)

2) PG Department— The submission of the college has been verified and observed that Dr. Sarika Jamwal resigned from previous college in Feb 2023 and she relived from the previous institute as per the e mail from the NCISM. But linking of teacher could not be possible due to some technical issue.

- 3. (1) There is deficiency of 4 Resident Medical Officers or Surgical or Medical Officer which can be considered under 20% relaxation as per MSR 2016.
- 3.(2) Radiologist and Ophthalmologist: Regarding shortage of Radiologist and Ophthalmologist we have 08 Part Time Modern Medical Staff out of 10 against the requirement is minimum 5 as per MSR 2016.
- 3.(3) Panchkama Nurse: Mrs. Annu Devi working as Panchkarma Nurse was relieved on 27-04-2023 due to her long absence from work, which was informed to the Inspection Team. In her replacement we did internal transfer of Ms. Reena Baloria, who was working as Staff Nurse IPD, from 29-04-2023 (copy enclosed) after the submission of Part-I. She was present on the day of Visitation in the Hospital Staff Group Photograph and was verified physically by the Visitors (photographs enclosed) and in support Copies of Salary statement, EPF, ESIC are enclosed (Annexure-IV)

She was present on the day of Visitation in the Hospital Staff Group Photograph and was verified physically by the Visitors (photographs enclosed). The photocopy of UG Degree

3.(7) Pharmacist: We were having 04 Pharmacist on the day of Visitation. We appointed Mr. Subhash Sharma Pharmacist on 01-05-2023 after Part I submission (copy enclosed). He was present on the day of Visitation in the Hospital Staff Group Photograph, in the Hospital Pharmacy on the day of Visitation interacting with the Visitors and was verified physically by the Visitors (photographs enclosed). - 5. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine(NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 49th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 27.07.2023.
- 6. In view of the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and board decided that the college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for Grant of Conditional Permission to Jammu Institute of Ayurved & Research, Muthi, Nardani Raipur, Ban Talab Road, Jammu Tawi-181123 (Inst. ID-AYU0044) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa 05 seats and (ii) Kriya Sharir 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra 05 seats under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24, but Board decided to issue conditional

permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2023-24.

"For deficiency of **every one teacher**, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity."

Accordingly as per Schedule–V Note (iii) of MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to sixty intake capacity shall not exceed more than ten percent of total requirement. As per the Hearing Committee observation and approval of Minutes in the 49th Board meeting of MARBISM, college is having only 26 total eligible Teaching faculty.

There is deficiency of 01 teacher for issuance of conditional permission for academic session 2023-24 as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of MSR 2016. <u>Therefore, in accordance of Reduction policy 2023-2024, for deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity.</u>

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2023-24 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 54 seats (instead of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa - 05 seats and (ii) Kriya Sharir - 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra - 05 seats course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.

- 7. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above, Conditional Permission is issued to the Jammu Institute of Ayurved & Research, Nardani Raipur, Ban Talab Road, Jammu Tawi-181123 (Inst. ID-AYU0044) with 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa 05 seats and (ii) Kriya Sharir 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra 05 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder for the academic session 2023-24.
 - The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - ii. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 15 PG seats in 03 PG courses seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
 - It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 9. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
 - (i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016
 - (iii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - (iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
- 11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
